

Terms & Conditions:-

1. For all works having estimated cost of work more than Rs. 5.0 Lakh value, Bidders must have an Experience of successful completion of similar nature of work of minimum 25% of the tender value in last 5 years .completion certificate of competent authority of concern department shall be enclosed.
2. NCCF shall be at liberty to distribute upto 40 % of the total tendered quantity of materials amongst other than L1 Bidders subject to acceptance of L1 rates by other than L1 bidders and fulfilment of eligibility criteria by them if offer for complete 100% is not received as per technical eligibility condition.
3. NCCF shall terminate the empanelment of a Business Associate if they have competed against NCCF in any bid either individually, as a partner or in a joint venture.
4. First preference shall be given to empanelled Business associate of Tendering Branch of NCCF.Second Preference (in case of absence of valid Business Associate of Tendering Branch) shall be given to empanelled Business associate of other NCCF Branches and third preference shall be given to Non Empanelled Business associate with a condition that they shall apply for empanelment with NCCF within a week of being declared successful bidder by submitting required document as per NCCF Business Guidelines and get themselves empanelled with NCCF before issue of formal letter of Acceptance.

5. All successful bidders will have to deposit a security Deposit (SD) of 2% of awarded value. EMD of successful bidders can be included as SD whereas in case of unsuccessful bidders, it will be refunded .NO interest will be paid on SD money. In case the client department demands security/ performance guarantee deposit of more than 2 % of the quoted value, the successful bidder shall deposit the same to NCCF.

## DETAILED TENDER NOTICE

Sub: **Export of Non- Basmati Parboiled Rice to Bangladesh.**

NCCF interested to export Non-Basmati Parboiled Rice to Bangladesh through eligible empanelled vendor. The Star Export House having experience in the import/ export business and having valid licence may apply as per details terms and conditions given below:

### QUANTITY:

1, 00,000 M.T. + - 5%

### ELIGIBILITY:

Bidders must have experience of successful completion of export of 25% of Rice of the tender value in last 5 years.

### PACKING:

Rice shall be packed in new Polypropylene (PP) woven bags of 50 kg net or as desired by the client. The size of 50 kg PP woven bag should be 24" x 36", tare weight of empty bags should be 120 Grams minimum. The mouth of the bags has to be double stitched by machine. New bags shall replace bags that bursts while loading and unloading by the seller and all charges in this connection should be borne by the seller.

### PERIOD OF DELIVERY OR SHIPMENT PERIOD

Shipment of one lakh MT of Non-Basmati Rice to Chattogram / Mongla Port within 60 days of opening of Letter of Credit ( L/C) or as per terms of buyers.

**PRE-SHIPMENT INSPECTION:**

The seller shall appoint well known & internationally reputed Pre-Shipment inspecting agency at his own cost to supervise the cargo and issue certificate on (i) quality, (ii) quantity, (iii) weight, (iv) percentage of broken grain, (v) content of moisture percentage, (vi) Percentage of total defects (dead, damaged and discoloured grains), (vii) Radioactivity ( if not relaxed) and (viii) Foreign materials, (ix) Packing etc.

**POST LANDING INSPECTION:**

After arrival of the rice at the port of destination the representative of the buyer in presence of the seller's representatives shall draw necessary representative samples. The sample will be tested in the local office.

**TURNOVER:**

Turnover should be minimum Rs 300 Cr

**TERMS OF PAYMENT:**

The payment will be released to sellers after getting payment from buyers.

**EMD:**

Rs 3.5 Crores in favour of MD, NCCF payable at New Delhi by way of DD/ RTGS.

Cost of Tender documents Rs. 5,000 + 18% GST

**INSURANCE:**

The sellers shall be responsible and liable for all matters related to insurance.

**NON-PERFORMANCE:**

In the event of non-supplying of the rice wholly or partly under the contract the seller shall be held responsible for any consequential loss causing to the buyer arising out of the non-supply of rice.

**THE LAW COVERING THE CONTRACT:**

The contract shall be governed by and constructed in accordance with the Law of Bangladesh and India as applicable.

**ARBITRATION:**

In case of any dispute, the Managing Director of NCCF or his nominee will be sole arbitrator and his decision will be binding on both the parties.

**OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS:**

- Preference will be given to firm who has successfully exported rice to Bangladesh earlier and also the preference will be given to bidders registered with NCCF Delhi Branch.
- Validity of bid will be one month.
- The firm who has filed any case against NCCF or NCCF has filed against the party will not be considered.
- EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be refunded within one month of finalization of tender.

- Tender without EMD will not be considered.
- EMD will be forfeited in case of bidder asked for modifications or not accept the contract after award of tender.
- All documents should be self-attested.
- Conditional bids will not be considered.
- NCCF reserves the right to accept or reject any bid without assigning any reason.
