- 1. The bidder shall be in possession of milling unit with a valid license and agreement.
- 2. The Bidder may employ multiple milling units, provided they have a minimum capacity of 10 MT per day for which they must provide details of each milling unit as per the tender conditions.
- 3. The average annual turnover of bidder in the preceding three financial years that is 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 (Provisional) should be at least Rs 20 Crores.
- 4. The Bidder must have experience of milling at least 2,000 MT of Red Gram Dal during last two financial years. The preceding last two years means 2020-21 and 2021-22.
- 5. All other terms and conditions as applicable by the APMARKUP.
- 6. For all works having estimated cost of work more than Rs 5.0 Lakh value, Bidders must have an Experience of successful completion of similar nature of work of min 5 years. Completion certificate of Competent Authority of Concerned Department shall be enclosed.

Introduction:

The Andhra Pradesh State Co-operative Marketing Federation Ltd (hereby referred to as "AP MARKFED") with Headquarters at Vijayawada was established in the year 1957. It is a federation of Co-operative Marketing Societies in Andhra Pradesh with the main objective of helping the farmers to secure better price for their produce by taking care of their market needs and providing agricultural inputs. Against this objective, AP MARKFED 's present activity consists of sale of farm inputs like chemical fertilizers, pesticides and seeds, maintenance of warehouses and procurement of Agricultural Commodities through its member societies.

The following are the functions of AP MARKFED:

- Supply of inputs like Fertilizers, Micronutrients etc.
- Undertaking price support operations
- Acting as an agent to the Govt for procurement, supply and distribution of Agri. commodities and also acting as the nodal agency for supply of inputs
- Warehousing of Agri-commodities
- Undertaking commercial operations of Agricultural Produce
- Owning and operating Agro-based industries as part of value addition
- Supply of quality consumer provisions

As an extension to its current activities and portfolio, AP Markfed ventured into the Consumer Food Business through Markup Pvt Ltd (A Consumer Division of AP Markfed) for value addition at primary and secondary processing of agri-produce with packaging and branding to bring synergy with the existing network and brand value. Essentially, it will assist the stakeholders, primarily farmers/ PACS / FPOs/ SHG etc., to get fair value of their produce and to enhance their income. At the same time, it is expected to provide consumers with the right quality of products at reasonable prices.

Markup Private Limited, has started its operations in the month of March 2022 and reached in the markets of AP and Telangana with its quality products. Taking this forward in view of providing healthy food to the consumers Markup is starting natural farming products in their portfolio. In this Markup will be supplying naturally farmed products to Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam, 11 other temples under endowment department and branded natural farming products to direct consumers under markup brand.

Background:

The Government of Andhra Pradesh has initiated a new Programme "YSR Sampoorna Poshana plus" for 77 tribal mandals, "YSR Sampoorna Poshana" and Supply of **Red Gram Dall** in the remaining WOMEN DEVELOPMENT AND CHILD WELFARE DEPARTMENT (WD & CWD) projects for implementation of uniform food models, duly superseding all existing supplementary and special nutrition models. Under this scheme, nutrition kits are provided to pregnant and lactating women as take-home rations (THR). WOMEN DEVELOPMENT AND CHILD WELFARE DEPARTMENT (WD & CWD) has 55607 Anganwadi Centers (AWCs) under its wing.

Markup has established tie-up with WOMEN DEVELOPMENT AND CHILD WELFARE DEPARTMENT (WD & CWD) to supply the required items to all the AWCs by leveraging its already existing strengths:

- Already existing in consumer food business
- Strong quality assurance systems and processes
- Presence of experienced field team across all districts
- Existing relationship with many millers and processors
- Already established itself competing with major food product brands in staples category
- Very Strong distribution network

In view of the above, Markup is looking for millers/manufacturers/processors for milling/supplying specified commodities/items. Scope of the millers are defined in the next section.

Scope of Work:

- 1. Red Gram Dal is one of the commodities being supplied to Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) under AP Govt Welfare Schemes as per the requirement of WOMEN DEVELOPMENT AND CHILD WELFARE DEPARTMENT (WD & CWD).
- 2. The bidder has to supply 1 Kg Packs of Red Gram Dal to all the AWCs in a Zone as per the indent received from Markup Pvt Ltd / WD & CWD from time to time.
- 3. The bidder shall ensure that the Red Gram Dal is compliant with the Quality Parameters and Packaging Specifications as elaborated in **Annexure VII**.
- 4. The bidder shall pack as per packing specifications and design given by the MARKUP and the processed Red Gram Dal per the quality specifications given by WOMEN DEVELOPMENT AND CHILD WELFARE DEPARTMENT (WD & CWD)/ MARKUP.
- 5. The bidder shall supply the Red Gram Dal 1 Kgs Packs to AWCs by 28th of every month as indicated by Markup on monthly basis during the contract period.
- 6. Intimating Markup team on the timelines of supply to ensure quality inspection is done before dispatch of the produce to AWCs (Anganwadi centers).
- 7. The bidder shall get acquainted with the nature of transportation and with the conditions of the route in the concerned district for transportation of packed stock. Once the tender is submitted, the miller will be deemed to have fully acquainted himself with the routes and he will not be entitled to any compensation on account of road blockade, diversions, etc. on the route.
- 8. The bidder shall make available, the number of vehicles required for transportation of Red Gram Dal of 1 Kg packs from mills to AWCs as per the indent / requirement issued by the Markup
- 9. The bidders will be given access to the Markup delivery management software, where they are required to accept the indent, create truck sheet for delivery of Red Gram Dal to AWCs, monitor the supplies, get the supply acknowledgement from AWCs & CDPO, check the invoices post acceptance and submit the same for processing payment.
- 10. The bidder shall collect the delivery acknowledgement from the AWCs and any other official as instructed by Markup once the delivery is made. This is important as the bidder need to submit their invoices along with the delivery acknowledgement to Markup for payment.
- 11. The quality and nutrition responsibility of Red Gram Dal lies with bidder till the time the stock is consumed at AWCs.
- 12. In case of any quality and nutrition related concerns raised by AWC or any other official deputed by Markup or ICDS department officials, bidder shall replace the stock within 72 hours at their cost.
- 13. Time is essence in the entire activity hence bidders shall take all required measures to ensure timely supply of material to AWCs. In case of any delay, Markup is free to purchase the material from open market to meet supply obligation and cost incurred in the process will be recovered from the bidder.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. The bidder shall be in possession of milling unit through ownership with a valid license and agreement.
- 2. The Bidder may employ multiple milling units, provided they have a minimum capacity of 10 MT per day for which they must provide details of each milling unit as per the format attached.
- 3. Miller may either be a sole proprietorship firm/ Partnership firm (duly registered under the provisions of Indian Partnership Act of 1932 as amended from time to time) or a Company (registered under the relevant provisions of Companies Act of 1956 or 2013).
- 4. The average annual turnover of bidder in the preceding three financial years that is 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 (Provisional) should be at least **Rs 20 Crores**.
- 5. The Bidder must have experience of milling at least 2,000 MT of Red Gram Dal during last two financial years. The preceding last two years means 2020-21 and 2021-22.
- 6. Bidder must follow hygienic & Compliance norms in handling and packing the goods.
- 7. The mills must have installed Power Generator of required capacity to overcome any power cut so that there is no delay in processing.

- 8. Bidder must have installed packing unit for packing of finished products in prescribed packing specifications as required.
- 9. There is no minimum order quantity assured in this contract. The Zone wise/District wise requirement mentioned in **Annexure III** is just indicative and **may change as per the requirement**.
- 10. Millers must enclose the following documents with the application:
 - a. FSSAI registration
 - b. GST registration
 - c. PAN copy
 - d. Bank Account details
- 11. The cost of tender is Rs. 5000/- + GST as applicable shall be paid by the bidder to AP MARKUP account.
- 12. No tender shall be accepted without enclosure of Tender cost.
- **13.** The bidder shouldn't have been blacklisted by any State/Central Govt. body/ Public Sector Undertaking at any point of time in India. The same shall be furnished as per the format prescribed in **Annexure IV.**
- 14. The bidder should not be involved in any major litigation that may have an impact of affecting or compromising the delivery of services as milling and transportation service provider of packed stock.
- 15. The interested bidder should not have been prosecuted for violation of rules / laws under the Essential Commodities Act or any such other laws or orders there under in any court of law. If any found later the bidder will be disqualified without any further notice and blacklisted.

Terms and Conditions:

- 1. The state of Andhra Pradesh has been divided into four zones. The zone wise division of districts is mentioned on **Annexure II.**
- 2. A single bidder can bid for providing services for one zone / more than one zone subject to payment of additional EMD for each zone separately and having additional turnover as required for each zone. That means if a bidder wish to participate in two zones they need to have an average turnover of 40 crores in last three years.
- 3. The initial period of hiring the Miller shall be **6 MONTHS ONLY.** A fresh tender will be released every 6 months for Red Gram or the contract may be continued for another 6 month subject to mutually agreed rates, terms and conditions.
- 4. It would be ensured by the service provider that there is no hindrance while carrying out day to day operations/ moving the stocks.
- 5. The bidder who has passed all the above-mentioned eligibility criteria will only be eligible for financial bids.
- 6. Financial bids shall be opened at Markup Head Office at Vijayawada.
- 7. Work will be awarded on lowest acceptable rates.
- 8. For any shortages and damages or any complaint in quality of the material reported at the AWCs, those stocks will be rejected and the bidder should replace the stocks as per the specifications at his own cost within the 72 hours.
- 9. If the service provider violates the standing instructions as contained in the Agreement, MARKUP have sole discretion to impose suitable penalties/reject the supplied stock/ cancellation of the contracts and further course of legal action.
- 10. The responsibility to comply with all statutory obligations, legal formalities, safety measures etc. under various Central/State Acts which are in force shall be the sole responsibility of the service provider.

Evaluation and Selection Criteria:

- 1. The method employed for the final selection of the bidder and award of the contract will be **L1** method i.e., Lowest Bidder Selection method after conducting Reverse Auction.
- 2. If the prices received are not satisfactory, the MD MARKUP will reserve right to negotiate with L1 or cancel the tender without citing any reason.

- 4. L1 will be calculated ZONE wise after Reverse Auction
- 5. The bidder who has passed all the above-mentioned eligibility criteria and found with the lowest bid shall be awarded as successful bidder and contract shall be awarded.

Procedure for bid submission:

The bidder shall submit his documents to the tender on e-procurement platform at https://tender.apeprocurement.gov.in by following the procedure given below:

- 1. The bidder would be required to register with the e-procurement portal i.e., https://tender.apeprocurement.gov.in
- 2. The bidders shall submit their eligibility and qualification documents in the online standard formats displayed in e-procurement website. The bidders shall upload the scanned copies of all the relevant certificates, documents etc., in support of their eligibility criteria and other certificate /documents in the e-procurement website. The bidder shall sign on the statements, documents, certificates, uploaded by him, owning responsibility for their correctness / authenticity. The bidder shall attach all the required documents for the specific tender after uploading the same during the submission of documents as per the tender notice
- 3. Registration with e-procurement platform:

4. Digital Certificate Authentication:

- 5. The bidder is requested to download the tender document and read all the terms and conditions mentioned in the tender document and seek clarification for any doubt from the Tender Inviting Authority. Any offline submission of the tender document shall not be considered.
- 6. The bidder has to keep track of any changes by viewing the addendum / Corrigendum issued by the Tender Inviting Authority on time-to- time basis in the e-procurement platform. The department calling for tenders shall not be responsible for any claims/problems arising out of this.

Payment Terms:

The service provider shall submit the invoices along with acknowledgements from the Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) to Markup every month.

On receipt of the invoices after due scrutiny and ONLY on receipt of payment from WOMEN DEVELOPMENT AND CHILD WELFARE DEPARTMENT (WD & CWD), Markup will release the payment to the service provider.

Payment will be released through NEFT/RTGS to the bank account details submitted by the service provider.

Period of Service:

The initial period of contract shall be for the period of **SIX MONTHS**, which can be extendable on mutually agreed rates, terms and conditions

Award of Contract:

Markup will award the work order to the successful bidder in writing that its bid has been accepted. On receipt of the work order, the bidder shall sign the agreement and submit the same to Markup within 7 days from the date of work order. After signing of the Contract Agreement, no modifications shall be entertained what so ever the reason.

Performance Bank Guarantee:

The successful bidder shall pay Performance Bank Guarantee i.e., 5% of the period of contract value. It shall be in the form DD/RTGS for Rs. 25 lakhs as cash component and the balance contract value shall be in the form of Bank Guarantee for 6 Months. The bank details are as given below:

Decisions and Instructions:

Except where otherwise specifically stated, the Markup decision shall be binding on the bidder. The bidder shall carry out all instructions of Markup pertaining to the contract and comply with the applicable laws.

Sub-Contracting:

Subletting of the work to any other party is strictly prohibited. If the selected bidder constituted field/office team internally, the accountability and liability of non-delivery will be of the selected bidder only.

In case if the bidder requires additional processing units to be employed to meet the delivery obligations, those processing capacities shall either be owned or leased for the entire contract period.

Penalty:

Any deviation in quality/ delay in supply/failure to comply the terms and conditions of the agreement, Markup will have right to procure the stocks from the available alternate sources and the differential cost shall be collected from the payables or otherwise from the contractor, besides imposing suitable penalties in addition to initiating appropriate legal action.

Delay in supply of the commodities beyond the stipulated time shall be treated as violation of terms and conditions of tender and appropriate action will be taken.

Blacklisting will be for a period of minimum three Months and extendable up to three years from the date of said order and the agency will be barred from participating in any tender of Markup/AP Markfed for that period. The Managing Director, Markup has the discretion to decide on waiver of penalty or imposition of penalty and/or extent of delay on case-to-case basis depending on gravity of the situation.

Foreclosure:

Markup reserves the right to foreclose the contract without assigning any reason. In such case, the bidder will not be entitled to any compensation.

Arbitration:

In case of any disputes arising out of the contract the same shall be referred to the Managing Director, AP Markfed or his/her nominee as arbitrator and his decision shall be final and binding on both the parties.

Tax & Duties:

The rates quoted by the bidder shall be inclusive of all the Government duties and taxes, (if any) and other duties and taxes levied by the State from time to time. Bidder shall be responsible for all statutory and regulatory compliance and for obtaining any permits, licenses or other statutory documents required by Government / Markup authorities in connection with the supply of Service.
