Subject: Allocation of Seed Minikits of Pulses under National Food Security Mission (NFSM) for Kharif 2022-reg.

Sir/Madam,

The undersigned is directed to convey allocation of pulses seed minikits for distribution to the farmers during Kharif, 2022. In order to promote quick spread of new varieties of pulses the Certified seeds of High Yielding Varieties (HYVs) of Arhar, Moong and Urad have been considered for allocation of seed minikits to the states during Kharif, 2022 of financial year 2022-23.

(2) The approval of Competent Authority for the operational modalities for adopting minikits distribution through the states during Kharif 2022 is hereby conveyed as under:

- As per the provisions contained in Para 14.2.2 (a) of Re-vamped NFSM Guidelines the National and State Seed Producing Agencies will supply minikits to State Government for distribution amongst the farmers. The Central/ State seed producing agencies will supply the certified seed in the form of seed minikits as per the allocation (enclosed) under National Food Security Mission (NFSM).
- ii. Allocation;

The state/crop/variety/Agency-wise allocation of seed minikits of Arhar, Moong and Urad during Kharif, 2022 is enclosed herewith at Annexure-II, Annexure-III and Annexure-III, respectively.

iii. The cost of Seed Minikits for reimbursement:

The cost of seed minikits to Central and State Seed Agencies would be applicable at the existing approved rate, as was conveyed by this Departments' Letter F.No. 3-1/2021-NFSM (C-92534), dated 13th July, 2021, hereunder:

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iv. The cutoff date for supply of Kharif seed minikit:

The cut-off date for supply of pulses seed minikits by the Central and State seed Agencies at destinations is 30th May, 2022. The Central and State Seed Agencies will supply the seed minikits within cut-off date at the identified destinations communicated by the State Governments & receive acknowledgement.

v. Destination point:

The states are expected to keep minimum points of delivery i.e one destination in a district to be identified and communicated by the State Governments to Seed Agencies well before the cut-off date, to ensure timely supply of seed minikits.

- vi. The State Government will be responsible for distribution of seed minikits to ensure timely sowing. The State Government to maintain record of supply, list of beneficiaries, acknowledgement by District Agriculture Officer, etc. and reporting of the programme to Gol.
- vii. The Government of India will not bear any additional cost including packing, transport, logistic etc under this programme beyond the approved cost of seed minikits as given above.

viii. Size of each seed minikit:

- a) Arhar/Pigeon Pea 4 kg
- b) Moong bean
- 4 kg
- c) Urad bean
- 4 kg
- c) Urad bean
- ix. <u>Supplementary materials</u>: Each minikit must contain treated seed, bio-fertilizer packets, leaflets having package of practices, characteristics of the varieties in regional, Hindi and English languages.
- x. The training programmes during crop season to be organized through District Agriculture Office and ATMA/KVKs for good agriculture practices and use of new seeds in subsequent seasons as well.
- State will also give the emphasis for distribution of seed minikits in the Aspirational Districts and maintain record.

xii. Acknowledgement letter:

Crop wise, variety wise quantity supplied in the district with date of supply and affixing official seal bearing name and designation of the State Govt. Officer must be mentioned on the acknowledgement letter for reimbursement of seed minikit cost to the Central/ State seed agencies from the GoI, under NFSM scheme, directly.

- xiii. <u>Progress Report</u>: Timely submission of progress report on the supply of seed minikits is to be ensured during Kharif, 2022, by the Central and State Seed Agencies to this Department and Directorate of Pulses Development, Bhopal.
- xiv. Implementation: There may not be any diversion in the targets approved for Kharif, 2022. After receiving the minikits at destination place/District, proper distribution of minikits to the appropriately identified farmers as per guidelines must be ensured by the District Level Agriculture Officer, concerned. The purpose is to ensure, that the identified farmer is capable of raising the crop with care & diligence such that the plot serves as a good demonstration to other farmers. One minikit per farmer and not more than 3 minikits in a season is to be given. Further, all records including the list of the beneficiaries, their complete addresses (mobile no. if available), results of minikits demonstrations, farmers' perception etc. must be mentioned correctly at district and State

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level for verification from time to time. It is further suggested that the State Department to undertake advocacy to the farmers, the new seeds should be used for sowing in subsequent seasons instead of marketing and consumption.

xv. The geo-tagging is mandatory for all minikits demonstrations field.

- xvi. If any type of issues arises regarding quality of seeds etc., in that case minikit distributing Agencies (Central/States Agencies) will be held responsible for all matters.
- (3) As per the practice, the cost of seed minikits supplied within cutoff date only be reimbursed to the Central/ State Seed supplying Agencies as per the allocation, by Crops Division on receipt of original bills supported with utilization certificate and first & final bill certificate with proper acknowledgement issued by the designated/NFSM State Nodal Officer. At the end of the season, the State Govts. to prepare a report on the targets/achievements, the benefits to the farmers, additional area coverage and productivity improvement and success stories. This strategy will be monitored by SFSM-EC by nominating separate nodal officer for this programme and preparation of report. In addition the GOI will also undertake field monitoring through Crop Development Directorates (CDDs) and National Level Monitoring Teams (NALMOTs).
