



Agriculture and allied sectors comprise crop production, livestock, forestry &logging and fishing. Among them, crop production has remained the dominant sub-sector with a share of 54.21 % in the sector.

Directorate of Agriculture is the nodal agency for the disbursement of seeds to the farmers at subsidized rate under various central and state government schemes. Directorate of Agriculture invites RFE from reputed seed producing Government of India/ State Government public undertaking/ Institutions/ Agencies for empanelment for supply of seeds in order to meet the seed requirement of the state.

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Section I:Background

The total geographical area of Jharkhand state is 79.72 lakh ha, and cultivable land for agriculture is approximately 38 lakh ha. The climate is dry with low moisture. The soil is acidic in nature and irrigation facilities are inadequate. Only 12% in Kharif season and 6-8% area in Rabi season is irrigated. The average annual rainfall of the state is 1280mm but 80% of it is received in a span of 100 days during monsoon. The main crops of Jharkhand state are paddy, maize, wheat, pulses, oilseeds, potato and vegetables.

Jharkhand is a rural state and 70% of the population is dependent mainly on agriculture. According to the 55th round of National Sample Survey Organization (NSSO), 10.46% of all households in Jharkhand faces seasonal food insecurity and 2.5% of the households face chronic food shortage. In view of the fact, that the area under cultivation is unlikely to increase significantly, thrust will have to be on raising productivity per unit of cultivated land.

Seed is the basic input on which the performance of other input factors depend. "Seed" is the basic input for increasing the productivity and production of the crops in the state. In order to empower the farmers, government provides certified seeds to farmers at subsidized rates in order to meet the local seed requirement. The government endeavours to undertake timely supply of seeds to the farmers in order to achieve better seed replacement rate. Food security depends on the seed security of the farming community ensure supply of high quality subsidised seeds will improve the efficiency of farm management and ensure high quality output.

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Section II: Objective& Scope of Work

Scope of work includes an indicative list of works which the empanelment of seed supplying agency would be subjected to during the period of empanelment in FY 2023-24.

- The empanelled seed supplying agency would be required to timely distribute quality certified seeds to the farmers with the help of their dealer network.
- The quality of certified seed provided by the empanelled seed agency should be as per the Seed Act, 1966.
- The empanelled seed supplying agency would be required to provide same variety of seed as required by the state.
- The empanelled seed supplying agency would be required to provide quality certified seed throughout Jharkhand as per the direction of the department.
- > The rates of varieties shall remain valid up to 31.03.2024.
- The purchase of seeds by the empanelled seed supplying agency shall be based on demand of farmers for particular crop & variety and shall be undertaken over the period preceding the cropping season.

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3.1 General Eligibility

A. LANGUAGE OF BID

The RFE must be prepared in English language only. If any document which is not in English it should be accompanied with translated and attested certified in English version.

B. SUBMISSION OF REE

- Not more than one RFE offer will be accepted from any bidder. If an individual/bidder participates in the RFE offer, representing more than one bid by one organization /Individual under one or different name than such multitude of bid shall amount to collusive activity and appropriate action should be taken by Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand under fraud and corrupt practices.
- b RFE offer have to be submitted through E- tendering online and also in the form of hard copy at Directorate Agriculture, Kanke, Ranchi.
- c The offer should be given in the prescribed format as per RFE document.
- d The submission of offer by any Bidder implies that they have read the terms and conditions of the RFE and have made themselves fully aware of the scope and specifications of the seed. Any addition or omissions in the original offer after opening of the offers will not be entertained (as per Annexure VII).
- e Individual signing of the offer should have valid digital signature and signing other related documents will attach valid acceptable proof of his authority to sign on behalf of the Bidder as per Annexure III.
- f The bidder should fill up the required information in prescribed formats and should upload all relevant documents as desired, failing which the bids will be rejected.
- g Once the online submission of bid is completed successfully the bidder must submit the hard copy of all the documents in the office of Director Agriculture 1st floor Krishi Bhawan Kanke road Ranchi before the last day of submission of hard copy.
- h Bidder should deposit the EMD as per the instructions specified in the RFE document. The original should be given in person to the Directorate Agriculture, by the last date of bid submission. The details of the tender fee and EMD, physically submitted must tally with the online details, otherwise the uploaded bid will be rejected.

The prospective tenderers having any common Partners/Directors/Managing partners etc. or having any other common criteria shall be considered as Sister / Group / Associates Company/Concern/Company. In such cases, only one of them will be eligible for participating in the RCO. Tenderers have to submit a declaration along

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with the Technical Bid, in the form of an affidavit on Rs.100/-, non-judicial stamp paper duly notarized, stating;

That no other Firm/Sister concern/Associate belonging to the same group is not Participating / submitting this RCO. (Annexure VI)

C.VALIDITY OF THE BID


- a Submitted bids shall be valid for 180 days from the Schedule date of submission of the Bid for decision and finalization of the RFE.
- b Prior to the expiry of the validity of the period of validity of the Bids, the Agriculture Director may extend the timeline of validity for a specific additional period.

D. PRESENCE OF BIDDERS

All the Bidders or their authorized representative, who respond to this notification, may be present on the date, time and place of opening of Technical Bids and Financial Bid, at their own cost.

E. RATES OFFERED

- a Rates submitted by the bidder should be firm and free from all escalations.
- b The bidder should quote rates F.O.R. all Destination in Jharkhand supplied through the district Offices, inclusive of applicable taxes, levies, duties transportations etc. Empanelled agencies must have to supply seeds block wise (department would order minimum 50 quintal seed supply for a particular Block)
- c Bidder should quote the rate of different crops Variety wise. The prices should be inclusive of all handling, packaging, transportation, taxes etc if any to the point of delivery as per the direction of officers in charge (Annexure IV).
- d As and when Gov. of India or State Gov. will revise the rates of GST that will be Applicable.
- c The rates finalized will be strictly for the use of Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand offices only.



F. PRE BID MEETING & ISSUE OF CORRIGENDUM

- a A prospective Bidder requiring any clarification on the RFE Documents may submit queries in writing on or before date of Pre Bid Meeting at Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand office.
- b Directorate of Agriculture at its sole discretion may provide response to the queries.
- c After Pre Bid Meeting Directorate of Agriculture may modify the RFE Document by a corrigendum.
- d Any such corrigendum shall be deemed to be incorporated into this RFE.
- e Any further corrigendum(s) to this RFE shall be published only on website http://jharkhandtenders.gov.in.

G. AMENDMENT OF RFE DOCUMENT

RFE once submitted cannot be amended. However, in some circumstances (such as major anomaly in the technical specifications having a major impact on pricing), Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand may decide to take fresh RFE from all or any of the Bidders before opening of the financial bid.

H. DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF THE BIDS

- a The bids will be received through E-tendering (online) and also in the form hard copy on or before schedule date & time.
- b The Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand reserves the rights to extend the deadline or for making any other change in the Bid document by issuing an amendment online in this regard.

I. VALIDITY OF RFE

Submitted bids shall be valid for 180 days from the Schedule date of submission of the Bid for decision and finalization of the RFE.

J. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (E.M.D.)

- a The bidder is required to submit EMD of INR 10,00,000(Rupees Ten Lacs only) either in the form of Bank Guarantee valid for one year or Demand Draft of any scheduled / nationalized / commercial bank drawn in favour of Director, Agriculture, Jharkhand payable at Ranchi.
- b E.M.D. of all unsuccessful Bidders will be returned.

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- c E.M.D. will not carry any interest.
- d EMD amount submitted by the previously empanelled agencies (For Seed Supply in 2022-23 in Jhrakhand State) will be considered for current RFE with a condition that they will additionally have to submit an affidavit stating that in the event of inability to fulfil terms and conditions e.g. shortfall in supply, delay in supply, supply of non standard seed etc for F.Y. 2022-23 in Jharkhand State, their firm will be fully responsible and liable for the same and an equivalent amount would be recoverable from them.
- e For successful bidding the bidder is required to submit the EMD and document required (both) well before the end of due submission time.
- f E.M.D. of bidder will be withheld if the Bidder at any time prior to its rejection withdraws the bid while the bid is still valid and also in case successful Bidder, fails to sign the agreement within the specified time limit.

K. FINANCIAL BID

- a Financial bid is to be submitted online as per format given in Annexure IV(BOQ).
- b Bidder may submit rates for all items or less items as he wishes to quote.

L. Security Deposit

- c The successful bidder shall furnish security deposit of amount of 5% (five percent) of the cost of the seeds to be supplied after the issue of "Letter of Intent" from Directorate of Agriculture in form of DD/Bank Guarantee in favour of Director Agriculture, Jharkhand payable at Ranchi.
- d The security deposit should be valid for minimum period of one year from the date of agreement and needs to be piedged in the favour of Director Agriculture Jharkhand.
- e After furnishing of security deposit and signing of agreement within above said stipulated time, EMD should be refundable to the unsuccessful bidder / bidders.
- f Once the successful bidder submits the security deposit then the department will return its EMD within 30 days.
- g This security deposit shall be withheld, in case of failure of execution of supply as per the supply order placed time to time or supply of any substandard material reported to be found, and agreement will be terminated and the Bidder may be debarred or blacklisted for submission of further rate contract

M. PURCHASE ORDER & SUPPLY F.O.R. DESTINATION

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- a The Director, Agriculture will be issuing supply order on the purchase rates finalised in the RFE as per the indents or demand received from the various districts, time to time on consignment basis.
- b The Bidder has to deliver the requisite quantity of "Seed" F,O.R. destination through District Office as described in order, which can be District or Block head quarters, or any other place as the case may be, with their own mode of proper transportation, in proper shape and condition to the consignee, within stipulated time schedule.
- c It will be mandatory for empanelled agencies to declare their stocks of the seed on their sale point and report it to the concerned Officer In charge.
- d The seed supplied by the bidder must be certified and recognised from seed certifying agencies of concerned state government. Seed certificate must be attached.
- e Bidders have to provide the details of foundation seed variety wise in respect of available certified seed.
- f Bidders have to give the supply and movement plan of the seeds from source to destination. Information regarding dispatch date, time, vehicle no., mobile no, etc, must be provided by empanelled agency after receiving supply order.
- g The supply order shall be on consignment basis and the un-sold stock if any, shall have to be taken back by the empanelled agency at his own cost(up to 5% of supply order quantity of the district).
- h It is necessary for qualified agency to produce the sample of seeds to the Director, Agriculture office as and when required.
- i Empanelled agency shall adhere to all the terms and conditions of RFE and the corrigendum publishes subsequently.
- j Director, Agriculture, Jharkhand reserves the right to segregate the quantity of seeds supply among two or more bidders or among bidders.
- k Empanelled agency should not sublet or assign his contract or any part of it to other vendors or local suppliers.
- All the necessary affidavit must be done through any Notary Office of Ranchi or other notary office of the country.
- The participant will mention lot wise quantity of seed supplied in the delivery challan and bills. The challan No. and date should invariably be indicated in the Bills / Invoice, when raised by the empanelled agency. The lot wise release Orders/ Certificates from the concerned Authority are to be furnished by the empanelled agency along with the bill.

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n Successful bidder/s should mandatorily and timely incorporate all relevant details in the blockchain based seed tracking platform developed by the Directorate of Agriculture/SATHI portal developed by Government of India.

N. PROCESS OF FINALISATAION OF RATES

- a After consent of parties and execution of agreement, rates will be circulated as required.
- b No offer will be accepted if the rates are quoted with the condition of minimum single order of half/full truck load etc.

O. PRICE FALL CLAUSE

- a The price charges for the offered item supplied under the contract by the bidder shall, in no case exceed the lowest price on which the bidder sells to other parties, private or government bodies.
- b If at any time during the said period, the bidders reduce the sale price of such offered item to any other person/organization at a price lower than the price chargeable under the contract, the bidder shall forthwith notify such reduction in rate to Director Agriculture. The price payable under the contract for the item supplied after the date of coming into force, of such reduction in sale price shall stand correspondingly reduced.
- c Director Agriculture Jharkhand shall be entitled to recover any amount paid in excess to the bidder in respect of sale which takes place after the reduction of price by the Bidder.
- d If the rate of similar products (with same specification) is found lower within the State of Jharkhand, Director Agriculture will have full power to cancel and recover the excess amount paid.

P. MODE OF PAYMENT

- a District Agriculture Officer shall make payment to the supplier against supply for the offered items and after receiving essential satisfactory sample report.
- b All payments against the supplies will be made only in the Name of the supplier on whom the orders for supply are issued. No payment will be made in the name of any other person or firm.
- c Payment of Suppliers bill will be made only after getting standard report of samples as per seed testing norms of supplied materials from a notified laboratory as per requirement of the item.
- d If due to any mistake extra payment is made to the Bidder, it will be responsibility of the supplier to point out extra payment and return it to Director Agriculture Jharkhand.

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Director Agriculture Jharkhand will have full authority to adjust such payments from security deposit or pending bills or next bills due for payment.

- e Seed shall be supplied after taking farmer share (50%) as advance by the concerned agency.
- f In cases with 100% subsidy on seeds it shall be supplied as per the order placed from the competent authority to block level.
- g The remaining cost/ subsidy part of seeds shall be paid to the supplier after delivery of seed to the farmer's and its satisfactory germination and different growth stage in the field and after sample report by concerned District Agriculture Officer/ officer in charge.
- h The supplier will have to submit all the receipts and challan at the office of DAO/ officer in charge to process the subsidy part of the payment.

Q. PROCESS TO BE CONFIDENTIAL

- a Information relating to the process of examination, clarification, evaluation, and comparison of bids and recommendations for the award of contract shall not be disclosed to Bidders or any other persons not officially concerned with such process.
- b Any effort by the Bidder to influence any officials of the department for processing of bids or award decisions may result in the rejection of their bid.

R. FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE

Neither party shall be held responsible for the non-fulfilment of their obligations under this agreement due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events, such as but not limited to acts of God, war, flood, earthquakes, strikes, lockouts, epidemics, riots, civil commotions provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such event the party affected there by shall give a notice in writing to the other party within one month of such occurrence or cessation together with the measures taken by it to mitigate and minimize the adverse effects of such force majeure event. If the force majeure conditions continue beyond six months, the parties shall jointly decide the future course of action.

S. FRAUD AND CORRUPT PRACTICES:

The Director Agriculture Jharkhand requires all the Bidders should observe the highest standard of ethics.

In pursuant to this policy, following has been defined. "Corrupt Practice" means behaviour on the part of officials in the public or private sector by which they improperly and unlawfully enrich themselves and or those close to them, or induce others to do so, by misusing the position in which they are placed, and includes the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value. "Fraudulent Practice" means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence an evaluation process of execution to the detriment of the Government and 15 | Page

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includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid price at artificial non-competitive level.

In such an event the Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand shall withheld the EMD and debar or blacklist the bidder from participating in future bidding processes of the Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand for a period of 1 to 5 years.

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T. COMPENSATION OF LOSSES OCCURRED DUE TO SUBSTANDARD

DEFECTIVE SUPPLY AND DEBARRING / BLACKLISTING OF SUPPLIER:

- a The Director Agriculture Jharkhand reserves its right to reject the lot / stock, if any material is not found conforming to specifications mentioned in the supply order or not found up to the mark and should be replaced immediately by the supplier on receipt of intimation from the consignee, at their own cost. In case the consignment is not replaced as specified, the consignee may have such material removed at the suppliers risk and the expenses incurred being liable to be recovered from Security Deposit, or from any sum due or which may become due to the supplier. No responsibility shall attach to the consignee for the safe custody of material supplied in excess and not so removed.
- b In case the competent authority feels that the continuation of the rate Contract—is not desirable, keeping in view the substandard supplied Material s/he can terminate the same, after issuing a notice, to explain the reason to the satisfaction of the competent authority. The Bidders can also be debarred or blacklisted by the Director Agriculture Jharkhand, to carry any further business / supply of such items in the State of Jharkhand permanently or temporarily, for a fixed period, as the case may be, if it is found essential in the interest of the state.

U. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

- a In case at any point of time bidder is found providing false information. Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand will not execute any rate contract (during process) or will cancel its rate contract (if rates of circulate) and the bidder can also be debarred or blacklisted from participating in future bidding processes of the Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand for a period of 1 to 5 years.
- b The Bidder, if breaches any condition or Clause of the Contract the Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand is entitled to Terminate the Contract and also entitled to demand and recover the loss incurred to it due to such termination of the Contract.
- c If the Government scheme is closed or partly revised or modified, due to Incidental decision of State/Central Government or any amendment and the proceedings of purchase is stopped or revised or modified by the Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand as a result of which the contract will automatically come to an end or partly continues, the Bidder is not entitled to demand/receive any type of loss amount or cannot initiate any legal proceedings against Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand.
- d In case of the any of the conditions in the RFE document are not fulfilled by the successful bidders it shall amount deemed termination of contract, furthermore it shall

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amount to Suspension/Debarment/Blacklisting of Bidder as adopted by Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand.

V. CONSEQUENCES OF CONSUMER FORUM AND ANY COURT OF LAW WITH BIDDER

The bidder shall own full responsibility for the consequences arising out of consumer forum or any court of law, In case any user approaches the Consumer Forum or any court of law with the complaint regarding substandard of ordered material supplied to him through the Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand.

W. JURISDICTION

In all cases of legal dispute, only the Ranchi Courts shall be having the jurisdiction.

X. EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT

The successful bidder will have to execute an agreement on Rs. 100/- non-judicial stamp paper of required value with the Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand in the prescribed format within a fortnight from the date of communication of acceptance of his offer by the Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand 1st Floor Krishi Bhawan Kanke Road Ranchi, failing to do which, the earnest money will be forfeited by the Directorate of Agriculture Jharkhand.


Y. Scope of Supply/Work: -

The bidder has to supply "Rabi & Kharif Certified/Hybrid Seed as per variety of different crops mentioned in Annexure IV.

Notwithstanding anything else contained to the contrary in this RFE Document, the Director Agriculture Jharkhand, reserves the right to cancel / withdraw / modify, fully or partially the "Invitation for RFE" or to accept / reject one or all of the RFE without assigning any reason and shall bear no liability whatsoever consequent upon such a decision.

3.2Technical Eligibility

- a Seed producing Government of India/ State Government /public undertaking/ Institutions / Agencies should have valid "marketing license of seed" from competent authority of the concerned state. In case if the seed producing agency is not having a valid trade/marketing license of the Seed from Government of Jharkhand, it will be required to register for the same in case the agency is empanelled. The registration process must be completed within 30 days from the date of empanelment.
- b The agency must enclose valid seed marketing license, from any state. If selected as empanelled agency, the agency would have to take valid licence from the state of Jharkhand.





- c The agency can apply for empanelment for one or more than one variety of seeds of different crops in a single application. It is mandatory for them to enclose last 5 years work experience from any government institution/agency with all necessary documentary proof.
- d Self-declaration on Rs 100 Non-Judicial Stamp Paper Notarized Copy(as per Annexure VII) that the bidder hasn't been blacklisted by a central/ any state government / institution and that there has been no litigation with any government department on account of similar services must be submitted.
- e Self-declaration on Rs 100 Non-Judicial Stamp Paper Notarized Copy as per Annexure VI.
- Seed certification for various seed must be enclosed with bid document. List of seed with varieties must be attached.
- g Self-attested copy of Quality test report/ Lab Report.
- h Self-attested Photocopy of Pan Card and GST registration.
- i Self-attested Photocopy of GST return of atleast any one quarter of the last 12 months.
- j Copy of ITR OR CA certified audited balance sheet for proof of annual turnover of the last three financial years (FY 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22)

3.3 Consortium

3.4 List of documents to be submitted as part of response to RFE

All documents must be properly marked and submitted. The response to RFE should be submitted in soft copy on e-tender portal and in hard copy at Directorate of Agriculture (signed on every page). In case of any discrepancy, the signed hard copy version will prevail.

The bidders are required to give two sealed covers containing documents/information as follows:

- Sealed cover-I: Technical & general information along with supporting documents & document fee and EMD (As per Annexure I, II, III, V,VI,VII)
- Sealed cover-II: Financial bid giving variety wise rate of seeds as sought in RFE documents. (As per Annexure IV)

Sealed cover-I and II should be provided together in a sealed cover.

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3.5 Disqualification

Director, Agriculture may at its sole discretion and at any time during the evaluation of application, disqualify any applicant, if the applicant:

- a Submitted the application after the response deadline
- b Made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements and attachments submitted in proof of the eligibility requirements
- c Exhibited a record of poor performance such as abandoning works, not properly completing the contractual obligations, inordinately delaying completion or financial failures, etc. in any project in the preceding three years
- d Submitted an application that is not accompanied by required documentation or is non-responsive
- e Failed to provide clarifications related thereto, when sought
- f Submitted more than one application on its own, or incomplete application
- g Was declared ineligible/blacklisted by the Government of India/State/UT government.
 Or is in litigation with government of Jharkhand.

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SECTION IV- EVALUATION AND EMPANELMENT PROCEDURE

In order to empanel agencies, Department of Agriculture/ Agriculture Directorate Jharkhand will constitute an Evaluation Committee to evaluate the proposals submitted. During evaluation of proposals Department of Agriculture/ Agriculture Directorate Jharkhand may, at its discretion, ask the bidders for clarification on their applications. The process for empanelment is as given below.

4.1 Evaluation process

Scrutiny of eligibility criteria as mentioned for responsiveness to the RFE will be done by the Evaluation Committee to determine whether the documents have been properly signed, qualification criteria fulfilled, all relevant papers submitted and whether the response to RFE is generally in order. The Evaluation Committee can seek additional information from the bidders, if needed. The response to the RFE not conforming to requirements will be rejected.

Technical Evaluation will be done on the basis of documents submitted as per Annexure II

4.2 Empanelment

It shall be deemed that by submitting the bid, the bidder has understood the scope, the contents of the tender document and all other relevant information pertaining to this tender.

The total cost of the seed including taxes, duties and all other expenses quoted by the bidder shall be considered for financial price evaluation.

The selection would be based on Least Cost Method.

Director Agriculture, Jharkhand shall not be liable for any mistake or error by the bidder in respect of their quotes.

At any point prior to the bid due date, Director Agriculture, Jharkhand may for any reason modify the tender document for any of its contents by issuing addendum.

The agencies shortlisted for empanelment will be required to sign an agreement with Director Agriculture Jharkhand, accepting the terms and conditions. After signing of the agreement, no variation or modification in the terms of the agreement shall be made except by written amendment signed by both parties.

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SECTION V: TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AGREEMENT

The agencies selected for empanelment will have to sign an agreement with Director Agriculture Jharkhand with the following terms and conditions.

5.1 Nativity

The organization must be incorporated in India as per GOI guidelines.

5.2 Relationship

Neither party shall use the other parties name or any service or proprietary name, mark or logo of the other party for promotional purpose without first having obtained the other party's prior written approval.

5.3 Right to rejection and Right to annulment

Director Agriculture Jharkhand reserves the right to reject any request for empanelment and to annul the empanelment process and reject all such requests at any time prior to empanelment, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected applicant(s) or any obligation to inform the affected applicant(s) of the grounds for such decision. Director Agriculture Jharkhand also reserves the right to employ seed village, KVK and seed farms of Jharkhand, outside of the list of empanelled agencies.

5.4 No obligation

Empanelment with Directorate Agriculture Jharkhand does not guarantee that any or all Bidders shall be awarded any project / assignment as a result of this empanelment.


5.5Confidentiality

Information relating to evaluation of application and recommendations concerning awards shall not be disclosed to the Bidders who submitted the applications or to other persons not officially concerned with the process. The undue use by any applicant of confidential information related to the empanelment process may result in the rejection of their application.

5.6Period of Empanelment

Director Agriculture Jharkhand shall empanel agencies for one year and extendable upto a period of 3 years.

The empanelment duration may be extended through mutual consent for a further period based on periodic reviews to assess the performance during the specified duration of empanelment at the same terms and conditions. Director Agriculture Jharkhand shall be



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free to curtail the empanelment at any time during the period of empanelment, without assigning any reason.

5.7 Indemnity

The selected Agencies will indemnify Director Agriculture Jharkhand against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark/copyright or industrial design rights arising from the use of software/ hardware/ manpower etc. and related services or any part thereof. DIRECTOR AGRICULTURE JHARKHAND stand indemnified from any claims that the hired manpower may opt to have by virtue of working on the project for whatever period. Director Agriculture Jharkhand also stand indemnified from any compensation arising out of accidental loss of life or injury sustained by the hired manpower while working on the project.

5.80nly one application

An applicant can submit only one proposal on its own. If an applicant submits more than one proposal, both proposals shall be disqualified.

5.9Amendment

At any time prior to deadline for submission of applications, Director Agriculture Jharkhand may for any reason, modify this document. The amendment document shall be notified through website and such amendments shall be binding on all Bidders.

5.10Disclaimer

This RFE is not an offer by the Director Agriculture Jharkhand, but an invitation to receive responses from eligible interested Bidders as seed supplying agency for Directorate, Agriculture Jharkhand. The Directorate Agriculture Jharkhand will empanel limited Bidders who fulfil the eligibility criteria. No contractual obligation whatsoever shall arise from this process.

The evaluation shall be strictly based on the information and supporting documents provided by the Bidders in the application submitted by them. It is the responsibility of the Bidders to provide all supporting documents necessary to fulfil the mandatory eligibility criteria. In case, information required by Director Agriculture Jharkhand is not provided by applicant, Director Agriculture Jharkhand may choose to proceed with evaluation based on information provided and shall not request the applicant for further information. Hence, responsibility for providing information as required in this form lies solely with applicant.

5.11Binding Clause

All decisions taken by the Director Agriculture Jharkhand regarding this contract shall be final and binding on all concerned parties.

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5.12Agency's Integrity

The Agency is responsible for and obliged to conduct all contracted activities as defined in the scope of work in accordance with the Contract.

5.13Agency's Obligations

The Agency will be obliged to work closely with the Director Agriculture Jharkhand's staff, act within its own authority and abide by directives issued by the Director Agriculture Jharkhand.

The Agency will abide by the job safety measures prevalent in India and will free the Director Agriculture Jharkhand from all demands or responsibilities arising from accidents or loss of life the cause of which is the Agency's negligence. The Agency will pay all indemnities arising from such incidents and will not hold the Director Agriculture Jharkhand responsible or obligated.

The Agency will be responsible for managing the activities of its personnel or sub-contracted personnel and will hold itself responsible for any misdemeanour.

The Agency is expected to maintain high level of professional ethics and will not act in any manner, which is detrimental to Director Agriculture Jharkhand's interest.

5.14Conflict of Interest



Services under this Contract. The agency undertakes to disclose all Intellectual Property Rights arising out of or in connection with the performance of the Services to Director Agriculture Jharkhand and execute all such agreements/documents and file all relevant applications, effect transfers and obtain all permits and approvals that may be necessary in this regard to effectively transfer and conserve the Intellectual Property Rights of Director Agriculture Jharkhand.


