TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR AUCTION/DISPOSAL OF OLD VEHICLES OF NCCF
AGAINST TENDER NOTICE NO. NCCF/HO/ADMN/DISPOSAL/2021-22/ Dated: 04.03.2022

Interested Persons/Parties may submit their highest price for the vehicle in a sealed cover latest by 03.00 pm. on 22.03.2022. The inner cover containing quotations and other relevant documents along with DD towards Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) should be sealed properly. The inner cover should be put in on outer cover and may be dropped in the box kept in the office of NCCF of India Ltd. at NCUI Complex, 3 Siri Institutional Area, August Kranti Marg, Hauz Khas, New Delhi-110016. Both the inner and the outer covers should be super-scribed in bold Capital letters "QUOTATIONS FOR DISPOSAL OF OLD VEHICLES OF NCCF".

2. The auction/disposal of the vehicles shall be strictly on "AS IS WHERE IS AND WHATEVER IS BASIS" and on "NO COMPLAINT BASIS" no guarantee or certificate of its worthiness or quality will be given by NCCF. The condition of the vehicles can be inspected physically from 07.03.2022 to 17.03.2022 between 12.30 p.m. to 3.00 pm at Head Office, NCCF of India Ltd., NCUI Complex, 3 Siri Institutional Area, August Kranti Marg, Hauz Khas, New Delhi-110016 by contacting Sh. Asit Chand Poricha, General Manager / Sh. Sachin, LDC. Tender forms with terms and conditions for submitting tenders can be obtained from the officer of NCCF on any working day from 07.03.2022 to 22.03.2022 between 12.30 pm. to 3:00 p.m. or may be downloaded from the NCCF website www.nccf-india.com.

3. The quotation should be accompanied by earnest money i.e. EMD of Rs.7,000/- (for Maruti SX-4) and Rs. 11,000/- (for Ambassador) as the case may be. The earnest money can be deposited in the form of Bank Draft issued in favour of MD NCCF. The bank draft should be attached with the quotation letter failing which the quotation shall not be considered at all. If the highest tenderer/successful tenderer accepted by the competent authority of NCCF fails to deposit the sale price within the prescribed time limit i.e. within 10 working days from the date of intimation to the tenderer(s) declared as highest bidder by the Competent Authority, his earnest money will be forfeited. In case the offer is withdrawn by any tenderer, the earnest money deposited by him shall be forfeited.

4. EMD of Rs.7,000/- (for Maruti SX-4) and Rs. 11,000/- (for Ambassador) as the case may be is payable by means of DD in favour of MD NCCF. (Payment by Cheque/Cash shall not be accepted). Offers received without EMD amount shall not be considered at all by NCCF.

5. The bid shall not be less than the reserve price or written bid submitted. If any, in relation to the vehicle.

6. The authorised person from NCCF will deal with the bidders directly and no middlemen/agents/ commission agents etc. should be asked by the bidders to represent their cause and they will not be entertained by NCCF. At the bidding, any bidder/s trying to form cartel with other bidders to otherwise influence the Bidding process may be evicted and his/their earnest money may be liable to be confiscated.

7. Conditional bid will not be entertained. If the bid is withdrawn by the concerned party/ Person at any time after it is provisionally accepted, the entire money already deposited by him shall stand forfeited.

8. The car shall be sold to the highest bidder inclusive of GST, if any on the basis of amount quoted in the bid.

9. The Managing Director or Authorized Officer / Committee of Officers, in its discretion, reserves the right to reject or accept any or all the bids, partly or completely, at any time without assigning any reason thereof. The decision of the Committee of Officers for avoiding the bid to the highest bidder shall be final.



10. It shall be presumed that the bidder has fully inspected the cars before their quotation. The committee shall not be responsible and shall not entertain any complaint in respect of any defect in the vehicle.
11. EMD of the successful bidders(s) will be released only after realization of Sale proceeds amount. Earnest money Deposit of the bidders who fail to honour the bid in prescribed time limit shall stand forfeited. No representation in this regard shall be entertained by NCCF. EMD amount of H1 bidder shall be adjusted in the Sale Amount accepted by NCCF. EMD of unsuccessful bidder(s) shall be released only after successful completion of the sale process.
12. The delivery of the sold vehicles will be arranged only after the successful bidder submits documentary evidence in support of residential status (Ration Card / Voters Identity Card in case of individual and Registration Certification in case of firms etc.)
13. The sold vehicles will be removed by the successful bidder(s) within 10 days from the date of intimation to the tenderer(s) declared as highest bidder by the Competent Authority. No assistance/transportation will be provided by NCCF. Permission to take out the disposed vehicles from premises will not be allowed on holidays, Saturdays and Sundays etc.
14. The successful bidders will also be responsible for getting the Registration Certificate of the vehicles transferred in his name at their own cost expeditiously. It will be the sole responsibility of the buyer for getting the necessary paper works done in accordance with the law and as per the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act (amended from time to time) applicable for Transport Authority of Govt. of NCT of Delhi. This office will not be responsible for any lapse on the part of the buyer in this regard.
15. EMD of the Bidder / Firms rescinding their offer, withdrawing or abrogating after submitting the bid shall stand forfeited. Decision of NCCF shall be final in this regard.
16. NCCF reserves the right to reject all or any tender in whole or part without assigning any reasons thereof.
17. EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned maximum within six weeks from the date of declaration of H1 bidder or successful bidder.
18. The bidder is required to reveal his full name/name of the authorized signatory of the firm/name of father, full postal address, telephone number & mobile number.
19. Disputes, if any, shall be subject to jurisdiction in the Court of Delhi only.
20. If the highest quoting bidder fails to honour the bid; the contract will be cancelled & its EMD shall be forfeited. In such an event, an opportunity shall be given to the next highest quoting eligible tenderer (H-2 quoting party) to complete the bid provided it is prepared to accept the prices offered by the H-1 party. In case of any dispute, decision of NCCF shall be final.
21. Tender form should be signed in ink by the authorized signatory only. Photocopy or unsigned quotations or quotations not signed by authorized signatory shall be rejected.
22. Tenderer / tendering firm shall alone be responsible for furnishing any false or wrong information and the consequences or loss thereof.
